### **Product Description**

A novel, psychometrically robust self-report questionnaire for children and young people-the FVQ\_CYP-that captures the functional impact of visual disability from their perspective. The 36-item, 4-point unidimensional scale has potential as a complementary adjunct to objective clinical assessments in routine pediatric ophthalmology practice and in research.
